1. Introduction

The District Credit Union ("we," "us," or "our") is committed to protecting your personal information and ensuring that your privacy is respected. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, share, and protect information about you in connection with our SMS text messaging service provided through RingCentral. By using our SMS text messaging services, you agree to the terms outlined in this policy.

2. Information We Collect

When you opt into our SMS messaging service, we may collect certain information, including:

Personal Identifiable Information (PII): Name, phone number, and account information. Usage Data: Message history, including the content of messages, message frequency, and message delivery status.

3. How We Use Your Information We use your information to:

Provide you with SMS messages about account updates, transaction alerts, marketing offers, and other informational messages.

- Authenticate your identity for security and fraud prevention.
- Improve our service based on your usage patterns and preferences.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your information based on your consent when you opt into receiving SMS messages. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by replying "STOP" or by contacting us at 303-360-0987.

Your information is only shared with our SMS messaging service provider, RingCentral, and any other third parties necessary to deliver the messaging services. All parties have agreed to secure and protect your information according to applicable laws.

We implement organizational and technical security measures to protect your information. While we strive to use industry-standard security, no system can guarantee complete security.
